

Ajmer Anise 1

Characteristics and Special Features:

It is the first variety of anise in India.
It bears attractive seeds and high volatile oil content of 3.2 %.
Seed yield: 7-8 q / ha.
This variety is from late maturity group.



Suitable Growing Region and Season:

This variety is suitable for cultivation in semi-arid region under irrigated conditions.

Ajmer Fennel 1

Characteristics and Special Features:

Seeds having volatile oil content up to 1.6%.
This variety has tolerance to *Ramularia* and *Alternaria* blight.
Seed yield 20-22 q/ha.
This variety is from late maturity group.
The plants are erect and tall, bearing large size umbels.
The seeds are attractive bold, medium sized, fragrant.



Suitable Growing Region and Season:

Performs well all over the country under irrigated condition.
