# Sree Athulya

### Characteristics and Special Features:

Triploid hybrid with high yield and high extractable starch suited for industrial use.

Sree Athulya is a high yielding (39.00 t ha<sup>-1</sup>) variety.

High starch content (34.80%).

The tubers are long cylindrical with brown skin and white flesh.

The cultivar is suitable for starch extraction as well as cattle feed.





It has been recommended for release and cultivation in the States of Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh.

Suitable for growing in Tamil Nadu in October -November.

Suitable for growing in Andhra Pradhesh in June.

## Sree Apoorva

#### Characteristics and Special Features:

Triploid hybrid with high yield and high extractable starch suited for industrial use.

Sree Apoorva is a high yielding (37.60 t ha<sup>-1</sup>) triploid variety.

Non/top branching plant habit.

High starch content (33.30%).

The tubers are big sized, long cylindrical with brown skin and white flesh.

The cultivar is suitable for starch extraction as well as culinary purpose.



## Suitable Growing Region and Season:

It has been recommended for cultivation in Tamil Nadu and Kerala.

Suitable for growing in Tamil Nadu in October -November.

Suitable for growing in Kerala in May-June & Sept-Oct.

## Sree Jaya

#### Characteristics and Special Features:

Sree Jaya is an early maturing (6-7 months) cassava variety.
Especially suitable for low land cultivation as a rotation crop in paddy based cropping system.
It has conical tubers with purplish rind, white flesh colour and has excellent cooking quality.



#### Suitable Growing Region and Season:

Suitable for growing in Kerala in May-June & Sept-Oct.
